HUD-VASH

Is a collaboration between HUD and the VA that provides a combination HUD housing vouchers with VA supportive services for homeless Veterans and their families.



78,000

Among several homeless continuum of care programs for Veterans, HUD-VASH enrolls the largest number and percentage of Veterans who have experienced long-term homelessness. According to the US Dep. of Veterans Affairs, as of Sept. 30, 2015, HUD had allocated more than 78,000 vouchers to help house Veterans.

Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) Programs.



SSVF provides case management & supportive services to prevent the imminent loss of a Veteran's home or to find a more suitable one.

Homeless Providers Grant and Per Diem (GPD) Program



Several different local/state organizations and non-profits receive grants and per diem payments to develop and operate transitional housing and/or service centers for homeless Veterans.

Other Programs:

Domiciliary Care for Homeless Veterans (DCHV) Program



It encompasses residential care for sheltered and unsheltered Veterans with several challenges, illnesses and needs of that nature.

Acquired Property Sales for Homeless Providers Program.



This program sells VA-foreclosed properties to homeless provider organizations at a discount to be used for transitional housing facilities.
